

MUSK FARM WELCOMES GARDEN CLUBS

Musk Farm is a glorious 1.4 hectare estate situated just a few minutes from the restaurants, cafes and shops of the Victorian spa town of Daylesford, about an hour and a half's drive from Melbourne.



Originally the house and grounds of Musk Farm were the 1872 Musk Primary School, which was decommissioned in 1993. In 1998 the hugely talented interior designer Stuart Rattle and his partner Michael O'Neill purchased the dilapidated schoolhouse and, over the next 15 years, expanded the cottage, developed the barren grounds into 14 exquisite garden rooms and transformed the property into a stunning country retreat. Musk Farm was sold after Stuart's death but subsequent owners have remained committed to caring for and continuing to improve the gardens. It is now a year-round show-garden estate.

Current owners Cathy and Mike Wagner welcome garden clubs to enjoy a guided tour of its established gardens and to share in the property's history and beauty. Musk Studio also provides accommodation and the estate is a wonderful location for intimate functions and events.
